



CHAMPAGNE TAITTINGER CELEBRATES ITS MOST SUCCESSFUL AWARDS YEAR EVER WITH THE HARROW



Champagne Taittinger is celebrating after the results of the Decanter World Wine Awards, the IWC Awards and the Sommelier Wine Awards were announced at the London International Wine Fair.

Of the eight Champagnes they entered into the Decanter World Wine Awards, Taittinger won five gold medals and one trophy, a feat not achieved by any other

single named Champagne this year.

The Taittinger Brut Réserve NV, Taittinger Brut 2004, Taittinger Folies de La Marquetterie, Taittinger Prélude Grands Crus NV and Taittinger Comtes de Champagne Blanc de Blancs 1999 all received gold medals, while the Taittinger Prélude Grands Crus NV was awarded the additional accolade of a Regional Trophy – Non-Vintage Champagne over £10.

In addition to this, the Taittinger Brut 2004 and the Taittinger Comtes de Champagne Blanc de Blancs 1999 won gold in the International Wine Challenge, with the Taittinger Brut 2004 scooping its third gold in the Sommelier Wine Awards.

To celebrate Taittinger have combined with The Harrow at Little Bedwyn to serve Taittinger Comtes de Champagne Blanc 1998 at £18.00 a glass and £115.00 a bottle, a reduction of nearly 50% and £50 cheaper than Harrods retail price.
